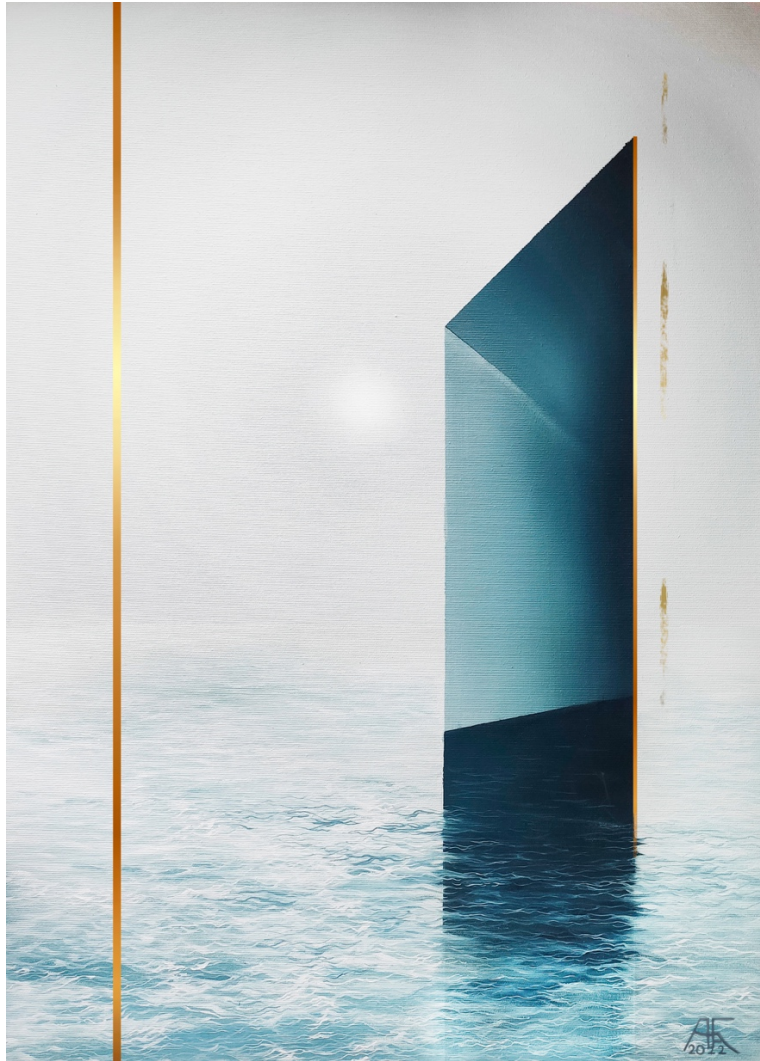

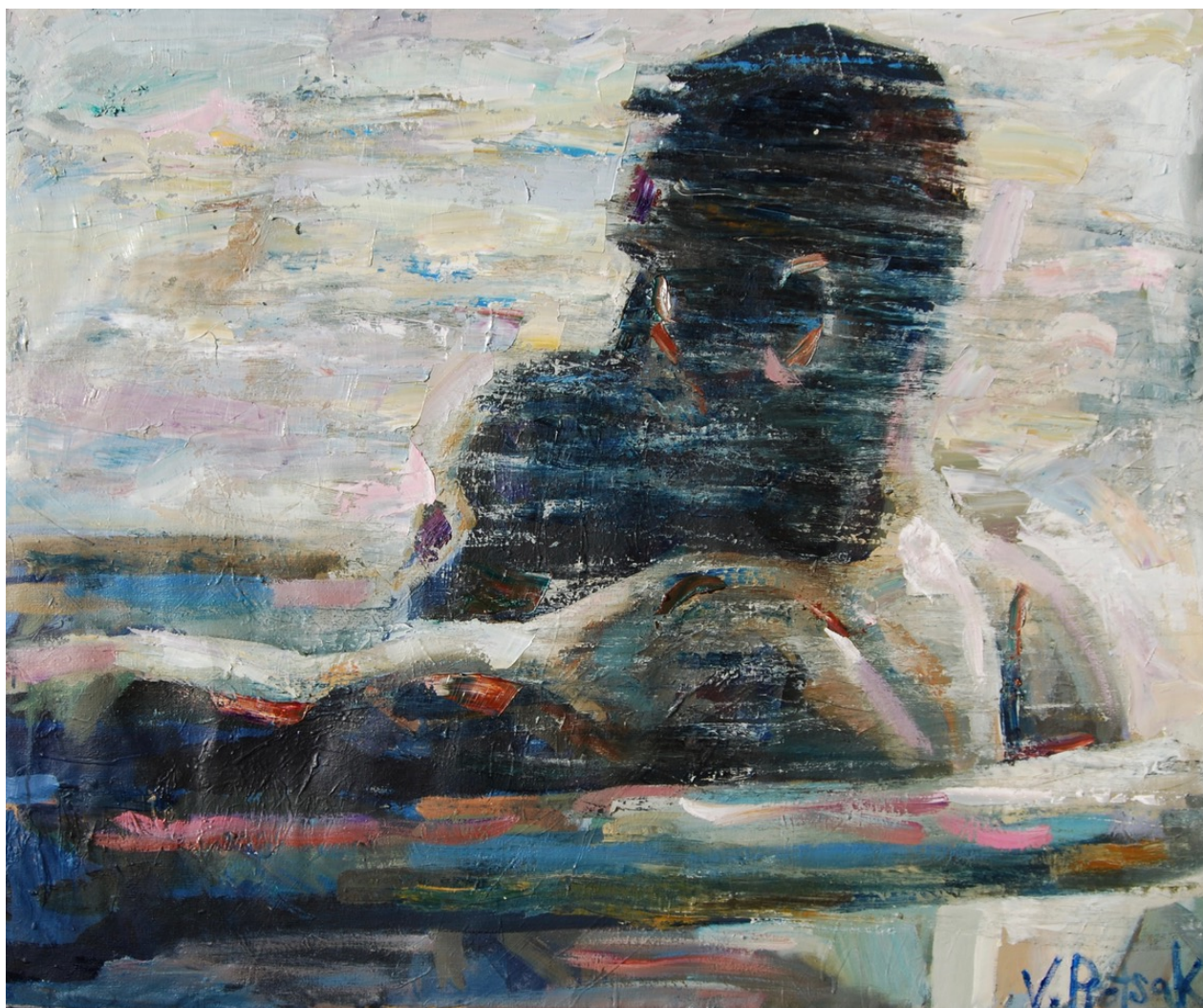

Valentyna Protsak lives and works in Zürich, Switzerland. She studied art at the T.G. Shevchenko High School of Fine Arts in Kiev and received her bachelor's degree in Fine Arts and Art and Design Education at Lucerne School of Art & Design.

Luiza Galbraith

Luiza Galbraith (the artistical pseudonym) was born and grew up in the city of Kyiv. Now lives in Switzerland, as she had to leave her home because of the war in Ukraine. Luiza Galbraith has been painting since she was 4 years old. She took part in Ukrainian and international art competitions and was a participant of group and personal art exhibitions. In Kiev, Luiza was the organizer of the Charity Art Project "The Essential is Invisible to Eyes".

All her life Luiza was inspired by nature. In her works, she strives to convey all the diversity of nature, capturing its fleeting magic. In her work, she mainly uses oil paints, forcing the brush to dance, because the most interesting things are usually reflected in the spontaneous dance and movement of the brush.

Her mission is "to create works that will be a bridge between the viewer and familiar landscapes that we sometimes don't pay attention to in a hurry" so that the viewer has the opportunity to take a closer look at the surrounding world, enjoy its beauty and feel the harmony of nature. After all, artistic objects that pay tribute to the natural world remind us of the need to slow down and help us to reconnect with nature, even for a moment.

Looking at the obvious, carefully observing and analyzing a topic to reveal it, is deeply is her process. The task is to go beyond the usual to be able to reflect one's unique self in artworks.
